

Dixie High School AFJROTC Course Drop Checklist

Revised January 2013

Must be signed before student can switch out of AFJROTC Course

When a student desires to drop any JROTC course, please communicate the following issues and ramifications to the student AND **advise Colonel Whicker of the intent**. Student and/or parent(s) should meet with Col Whicker or one of the Senior Master Sergeants to provide feedback as to what would make the program better.

If the student would like to drop a course or courses, they should consider:

The Student's Responsibility to the Program:

- Any remaining fees (uniform, books, fundraising materials etc..) for the course or tuition owed depending on the withdrawal date must be paid directly to the Finance Office at Dixie High School - Mrs. Patti Harris.
- Uniforms and Books must be returned in person to Col Whicker or one of the Senior Master Sergeants. **They cannot be dropped off at any school office or received by a school counselor or secretary!**

Scholarships/Careers:

- If the student is looking to go to college, he/she should realize that their withdrawal from AFJROTC could affect some of their scholarship opportunities especially if they are looking at ROTC or Academy nominations. The leadership and community service plus the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor's (SASI's) recommendation are of paramount importance.
- Students desiring to enlist in the military earn the rank of E-2 when they complete two full years of JROTC, and E-3 after they complete three or more years. **There's \$3060.00 annual pay difference from E-1 to E-2; and a \$3963.60 difference from E-1 to E-3.** This is significant, if the cadet is planning to join the military.

CHECKLIST FOR DROPPING JROTC:

- Dry Cleaned Blue Uniform returned or \$25.00 cleaning fee collected.
- Textbooks returned to Dixie High Media Center (Leadership and Aerospace Science, Pilot Ground School)
- Clear the Dixie High School Finance Office for fees, dues, etc...
- Were fundraising tickets, brochures, and other equipment returned?

DUE TO THE GOVERNMENT FUNDS INVOLVED, COUNSELORS CANNOT DROP STUDENTS UNTIL THEY RECEIVE THIS FORM (or a similar note) FROM THE JROTC CADRE
